Minutes of Previous Meeting:

The minutes of the 2018 AGM were accepted.

President's Report:

Peter Gallagher, presenting his first report as President, welcomed Sophie Robinson back to Bathurst, Sophie having not ridden for some time due to illness. He welcomed new member Steve Arthur to the rally (2017 President's Award winner) and also welcomed the return of Bob Moss to the rally and TMRA membership. Peter thanked Lorraine for running a great Southern Triples Rally in Gunning and reminded the meeting of the great effort Col and Nancy once again put into running the wonderful Aussie Triples rally in Evans Head, attended by quite a few TMRA members. Peter thanked the committee and members for their support, particularly those who helped to run regional events in Bega, Kurri Kurri and Canowindra, and also Peter Shoemark for his efforts with the TMRA website. It was also noted that many members had attended the memorial ride for Vince Hayes, held in Kandos.

Treasurer's Report:

During the last financial year the club's financial balance decreased from \$14,117 to \$12,845. This reduction was substantially due to our two \$500 donations for 2016-17 not having not being made until 2017-18 (see item under General Business). The financial report has been audited, and was accepted by the meeting.

Events Officer's Report:

Lorraine said that numbers were satisfactory for the Bathurst Friday and Sunday rides and she would continue with them next year. She is not conducting a Central West (Canowindra) weekend this year but hopes to run a similar weekend in February or March 2019. South Australian members have suggested that the Southern Triples Rally be held mid-way between Canberra and SA, and to this end Lorraine intends to look around Central Victoria, perhaps Bendigo or Horsham, on her way to the BSA International Rally in Halls Gap later this year.

Machine Registrar's Report

Lorraine advised that the 60-day concessional registration 'trial' had now been made permanent in NSW.

Membership Director's Report:

In Bernie's absence the Secretary advised the AGM that club membership was now around 70, with eight new members in the past year. Donations to charitable causes

The Secretary advised that, following discussion at the 2017 AGM, a donation of \$500 had been made to Neuroscience Research Australia (NeuRA), formerly the Prince of Wales Medical Research Institute, that investigates not only motor neurone disease but also brain injury suffered through motorcycle crashes. TMRA will continue with annual NeuRA donations and will also continue with its \$500 donation for heart disease research.
