MINUTES

Triumph Motorcycle Register of Australia Annual General Meeting

Via Zoom, Saturday 19 September 2020

Meeting opened 4.08 pm

Welcome by President

Peter Gallagher noted the passing of his father and members Vance Tomlinson and Sophie Robinson. He apologised for the cancellation of the annual rally due to Covid restrictions and the resultant inability of the Panorama Motel to handle our large group. Peter said it was good that regional rides had resumed, and expressed the hope that 2021 would be a better year for the club.

Minutes of Previous Meeting (distributed with the 2020 agenda)

Minutes of the 2019 AGM agreed to.

Treasurer's Report

Bob Russell's report showed an end-of-year balance \$7,738 a reduction of \$2,663 over the year due predominantly to our continued donations to NeuRA and the Heart Foundation (see General Business), and the sale of subsidised regalia, undertaken as part of TMRA's efforts to increase benefits to members. Note that the non-payment of membership fees for the upcoming year will have a further impact on funds during 2020-21.

Membership Director's Report

Bernie Clark indicated that membership totalled 67 (including 12 currently non-financial members), with five new members joining in the past 12 months—Andrew Rowan (Wellington Point, Brisbane), Chris Haywood (Cooranbong NSW), Vic Olivieri (Goonellabah NSW), Stan Topp (Albany Creek, Brisbane) and Paul Withers (Castlereagh NSW).

Events Officer's Report

Lorraine Litster advised that she had established that Beechworth, in north-eastern Victoria, would be a suitable location for our next Southern Triples Rally. After discussion on the most appropriate area or state to hold the rally, the meeting decided that Lorraine should make a tentative booking with the venue she had investigated in Beechworth. Lorraine also advised she was thinking of holding another NSW Central West weekend in Canowindra.

Regional Representatives' Reports

Toby Bateman (Shoalhaven) indicated in his written report that most events had been cancelled due to Covid. He also advised that he had contacted the NSW Premier's Office about the legality of riding motorcycles during Covid restrictions and had been informed that motorcycling was considered as exercise and therefore was legal. Toby also reiterated his request for club stamps to be issued to assistant registrars, and Lorraine Litster undertook to complete this task. In particular, Toby thanked Brian Eldred, on the occasion of his retirement from the committee, for his work since the inception of TMRA. (The committee has also received other messages of thanks to Brian.)
