SOUTHERN TRIPLES RALLY GUNNING 2021: 12-14 March **THE COVID BUSTER RALLY**

In 2021 the TMRA Southern Triples Rally will return to the pretty country town of Gunning, about 70 km north of Canberra where our rally was held in 2018.

Due to the ongoing threat of rapid border closures TMRA determined that holding this event outside NSW was unfeasible.

There is wonderful riding in this area as those of you who came in 2016 & 18 will know. It is ideal country for these magnificent Triumph & BSA Triples from 1968-76. Other Meriden Triumphs are also welcome to enter. However:

All the facilities in Gunning—accommodation, cafes, petrol, pub, ATM, post office—are within walking distance of each other.

Xania from the Old Hume Cafe has undertaken to provide breakfasts & evening meals for us as she did in 2018.

We require you to book your own Accommodation at the Motel (which only has 15 rooms available presently). You could also bring a caravan or camper trailer, for the free site.

Full Rally timetable & ride routes will be provided upon arrival in Gunning.

The Rides

There will be a ride on Saturday and Sunday.

The Saturday Ride will be ~240Km

The Sunday ride will be about 150Km.
